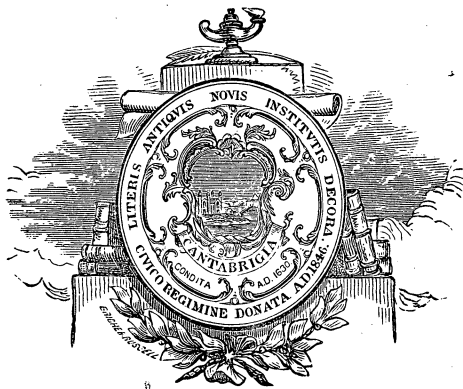




CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.

Oct. 27. 1884.

WHEREAS: It is adjudged by this Board that the public necessity and convenience require that

Fidney Street
between *Henry and Chestnut Streets*

should be laid out as a public Street. Ordered that a strip of land -

in width between *said Henry and Chestnut Streets* *forty feet*

included between the *red* lines as shown on a plan drawn by *Arthur Hodges*
Care Engineer, dated July 9. 1884,

and now before this Board, be taken for public use and laid out as a public Street.

Ordered that *no* damages be allowed for the land so taken as aforesaid,

Sent down for execution.
