- WHEREAS: Kurt was a member of 256th Infantry Brigade, Louisiana Army National Guard; and
- WHEREAS: Kurt's passing will leave a void in the lives of all his surviving family; and
- WHEREAS: Kurt will be sorely missed by all he touched and loved; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to the family of Sergeant 1st Class Kurt Comeaux at this time of such personal loss; and be it further
