ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to direct the Traffic Director to close off Brattle Street (Brattle Square) from Massachusetts Avenue - Boylston Street to Church Street to vehicular traffic, thereby creating a pedestrian mall, from 6 o'clock P. M. to midnight every Friday, Saturday and Sunday evening, from the First of June until the day after Labor Day and to set up proper signs and "wooden horses" at all entrances to the area notifying one and all that the Brattle Square has been designated as a peoples mall.
