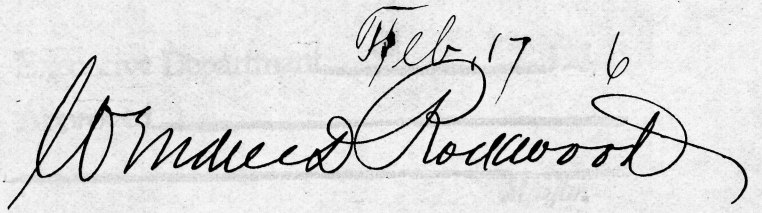

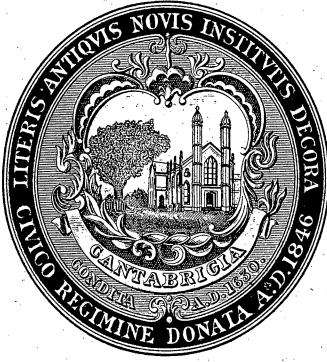

Honorable the City Council of the
City of Cambridge:-

I understand that the Board of Health of the City of Cambridge has officially abandoned the building on Reservoir Street for further use as a hospital for contagious diseases, and that this information was transmitted to the City Council of last year.-

I feel that to permit this building to stand and to have persons thoughtlessly and unwittingly about the premises, and possibly to enter the building might result in the possibility of spreading disease; Furthermore, I understand that the property in this immediate vicinity is being developed, and the persons interested feel that to permit this building to stand, is a detriment to property interests in this vicinity.

I therefore respectfully recommend that the Chief of the Fire Department be authorized to cause this building to be destroyed by burning.
