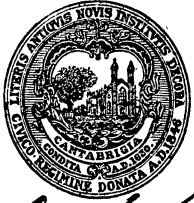

Dear Sir:-

I wish to renew my request of recent date in regard to restraining dogs during the present epidemic of rabies in the city. I have taken the matter up with the Chief of Police and recommend the employment of a dog catcher and an automobile from the Animal Rescue League and the designating of such members of the police force as you determine to assist in the collection of unrestrained dogs. The Chief of Police will be able to give you an amount per day which will be charged by the Animal Rescue League and I recommend at least three days per week until September 1st.

The matter is assuming a very serious aspect, there having been thirty-nine cases of dog bite since January 1st, ten of which have been positive rabies and five cases which have received Pasteur treatment at our board of health office.

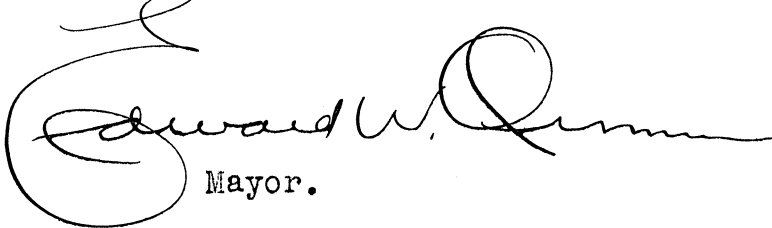
