To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting the transfer of \$16,000 from the Reserve Other Ordinary Maintenance Account to the Community Development Other Ordinary Maintenance Account to fund the remaining portion of the contract for facilitation and planning support associated with the rezoning of the W.R. Grace site in North Cambridge. Additional work has been necessitated by the fact that the public meeting and group facilitation process necessary to forward a zoning recommendation to the Planning Board, and subsequently to the City Council, took longer than expected. The additional amendment to the contract covers two more working group meetings, a small group negotiation session, and an additional appearance before the Planning Board and preparation of preliminary and final reports on the entire process.
