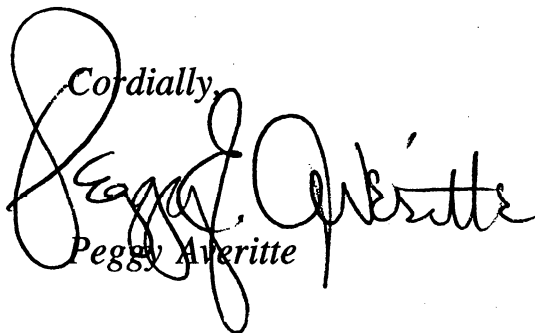

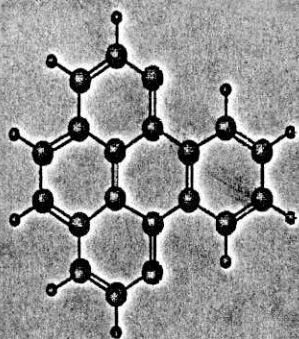
Dear Community Member:

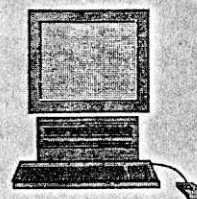
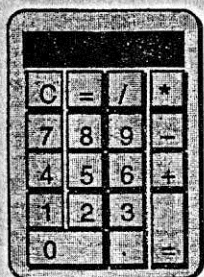
