AN ORDINANCE

In amendment to an Ordinance in relation to the Hospital Department.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Cambridge as follows:

Section ~~2~~² of the ordinance in relation to the Hospital Department is amended by striking out the word "may" in the seventh line and inserting in place thereof the word "shall"

Section 5^{is} amended by striking out the entire section and inserting in place thereof the following:

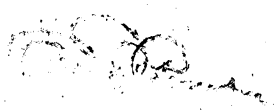
Section 5 There shall be a staff of six (6) on the medical and six (6) on the surgical side. All to be of equal rank and to serve for a period of two months each. Each physician and surgeon shall have at least two assistants.

There shall be no chief surgeon or Chief Physician appointed. The members of the staff shall be appointed by the trustees.
