I hereby request an appropriation in the amount of \$162.86 to reimburse Frank Misener, an employee of the Water Department for damages in this amount.

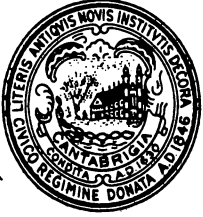
The Law Department, under the provisions of General Laws, Chapter 41, Section 100-A, defended an action against Frank Misener in which there was a judgment of \$162.86.


