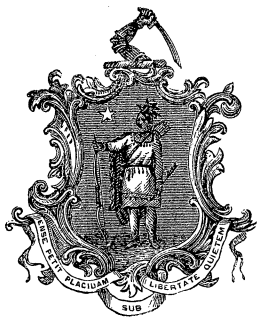
City Hall, Boston, Aug. 24, 1869.

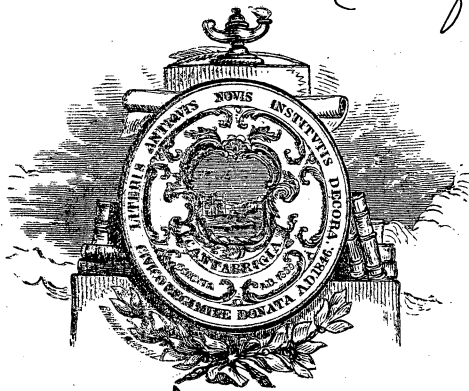
