NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

On October 31, 1983, Wyman-Gordon Company filed a petition with the Department of Public Utilities requesting that the Department amend its present cost of gas adjustment clause regulations as adopted by the Department in D.P.U. 19806-A/20147 (October 16, 1980), and as presently codified at 220 C.M.R. § 6.01-6.11. The Petitioner incorporated by reference in its petition certain proposed cost of gas adjustment clause regulations.

Pursuant to G.L. c. 30A, § § 2 and 4, the Department will hold a second hearing on Tuesday, June 12, 1984 at 10:00 o'clock in forenoon at the Department's Offices, #1210 Leverett Saltonstall Building, 100 Cambridge Street, Boston, Massachusetts to determine whether it should adopt the proposed amendment to its regulation.

At this hearing, the Department will be versed on the progress of the informal discussion group which has been meeting at various times since the initial hearing which occurred on March 15, 1984. At this second hearing, the Department will entertain any formal statements, position papers, or alternative cost of gas adjustment clauses.
