Dear Henrietta,

I am now officially retired from the Ski Club. The past eight years as club advisor have been very rewarding but extremely stressful. George and I estimate that in it's twenty years of existence the club has supported 14,000 skier days, about 3,000 of which were individual skiers, and 1,000 were new to the sport. We are extremely proud of this accomplishment and hope that someone (Jon Baring-Gould) will step forward to help continue the tradition.

We now enjoy a wonderful relationship with Sugarbush Resort in Warren, Vermont. Five years ago when the cost of a trip was increasing to the point where we almost closed down Sugarbush offered us a financial package that to this day seems to good to be true. Shawn Sullivan the manager of Group Sales arranged a discount package that would allow us to rent skis, and have lessons provided for beginners, along with lift tickets for everyone else that couldn't be matched anywhere in New England. To this day our price at Sugarbush allows us to offer low cost skiing/riding to any CRLS student. This year we were able to ski 650 days at Vermont, Maine, and Canadian resorts.

We would appreciate it if you could arranged a proclamation thanking Shawn Sullivan for his help and generosity over the last five years. We are also looking forward to another five years of cooperation and friendship between Sugarbush Resort and the students of Cambridge Rindge and Latin School. Shawn has been wonderful to us and whoever takes over for George and I could always use a little help in negotiating a new package. This proclamation would surely help.
