M., is assigned as the time for hearing any objections which may be made thereto.

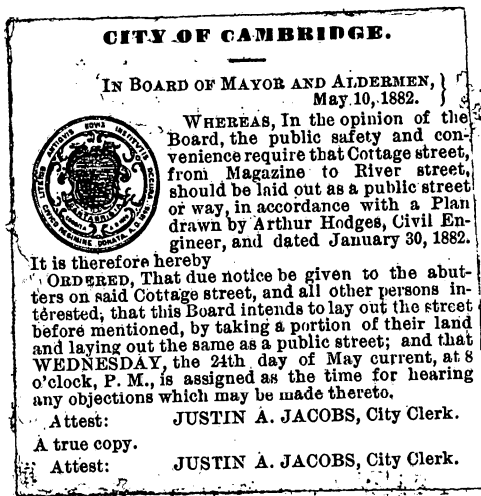
