WHEREAS: On Tuesday, February 18, 1992, in Boston, Mr. Iwao Matsuda, President of Chukyo University, Nagoya, Japan, was tragically struck down by a person unknown; and

WHEREAS: Mr. Matsuda was in Boston to create a sister university relationship between Chukyo University and the University of Massachusetts that would have fostered student and faculty exchanges in order to strengthen ties between Japan and the United States and to promote peaceful international understanding; and

WHEREAS: The City of Cambridge has special ties of friendship and cultural exchange with its sister city of Tsukuba, Japan; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to the family of Mr. Matsuda, at this time of personal loss; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the City Clerk hereby is requested to forward three copies of this resolution, suitably engrossed, to Mr. Toshio Mochizuki, Consul General, Boston, on behalf of the entire City Council, with the request that the three resolutions be transmitted to the family of Mr. Matsuda, to the administration of Chukyo University, and to the Mayor and City Council of Tsukuba, Japan.
