Fence & Trees in three weeks. I would ask
your honorable Body to revoke that order
as relates to my Fence & Trees to some suitable
time as the land is low & the trees are large
& weather cold & so much water the roots
with Fences & would nearly kill the Trees or
at any rate would injure them very much
I do not think the City wishes to put me
to any unnecessary expense - as the sidewalks
on Howard & Calumet streets were made
by me. ~~the~~ was a nuisance to the neighborhood
they were filled up by me and no expense to
the City I have built about 600 feet of

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side walks about my place in the Port
and about 200 feet in width one all at
my expense I believe not only ^{one} instance
hence the City men quarrelled in my front on
the side walk & then one ~~some~~ few loads

Body so to modify your previous order so
not to cause my sense & please this
winter as the Publick will not be injured
by its not being done. if some individuals
should be - granting this ~~my~~ request
you will oblige ~~your~~ humble servant
