AMENDED ORDER 4. IN CITY COUNCIL

VICE MAYOR REEVES

WHEREAS: Enjoyment of the arts plays an important role in bringing people together and uplifting their spirits; and

WHEREAS: During these times of recession and the myriad problems that beset our society, it is particularly important that people find a more than occasional oasis of pleasure and cross-cultural understanding in their lives; and

WHEREAS: The Cambridge Arts Council is an appropriate city agency by which this city government can provide such opportunities; and

WHEREAS: The current budget for the Cambridge Arts Council allows for only one staff person, and no program budget, now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That this City Council request the City Manager to consider, in the 1991-1992 budget appropriations, funding for costs related to programs such as the Summer Outdoor Concert Series; future activities of the Cambridge Chorus and Orchestra; a Multicultural Theatre series; Cambridge Riverfest; and other programs as determined by the Cambridge Arts Council; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to furnish this City Council a preliminary report outlining such costs prior to the submission of the FY 92 operating budget.
