

Cambridge, July 8. 1884

My dear Mr. M. Duffie,

In reference to the plan of Lower Street, I am informed by Mr. Barber that he is waiting for orders from the Committee on roads & bridges - Consequently, you will do me a favor if you will present the matter to the Committee at their meeting this p. m.
