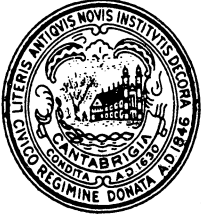

Subject : Council Order No. 25 - Vice-Mayor Russell - October 25, 1982
Re: Concord Avenue

I cannot find any Council Order that requested information concerning the resurfacing of Concord Avenue "from Story Street to the Belmont Line." However, I am submitting the following information in regard to future work:

1. The area from Garden Street to Buckingham Street, currently involved in the Phase V sewer program, will have a final surface installed in the spring of 1983. In the meantime, the street has been temporarily patched to insure good conditions over the winter.
2. From Buckingham Street to Huron Avenue, on the outgoing lane, a new pavement strip has been placed, as previously requested by the Council. No further work is contemplated in this area at this time.
3. From Huron Avenue to the Rotary, no work is contemplated in the near future, other than routine maintenance.
4. From the Alewife Rotary to the Belmont line, it is anticipated that this area will be resurfaced within two years, following completion of all Alewife project work. Current areas effected by sewer construction, have been patched temporarily to hold for the winter. Permanent patching will be completed in the spring of 1983.
