WHEREAS:-

Roosevelt Towers has been declared by the Health Commission to be not up to the standards of the Cambridge Housing Code ; therefore be it

ORDERED:-

That the Cambridge Housing Authority be and hereby is requested to investigate the possibilities of using the flexibility provided by the new housing to reassign all tenants in the tall building at Roosevelt Towers and demolish said building; and further be it

ORDERED:-

That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to have the Planning Department assist in the investigation.
