2. The purposes for which the corporation is formed are as follows:

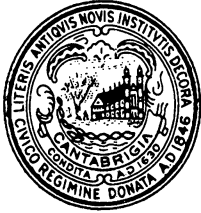
The Society is formed for purely religious, social and educational purposes. The main objective of the Society is to propagate the philosophy and practices of yoga. The philosophy of yoga is a science of mind and body. It is not a separate religion. Hence, the religious purpose of the Society is to be interpreted only in this sense: that the Society wishes to preach a "universal religion". Other aims and objectives of the Society are as follows:

(1) To work for the development of a universal society and the welfare of human beings through (a) literacy drives, (b) social service and reforms, (c) relief work among suffering humanity, (d) encouraging literary and artistic faculties, (e) spiritual, moral and cultural upliftment, and (f) development of integrated human personality embracing all spheres of life.

(2) To exert all resources for the cause of peace, security and universal fraternity.

(3) To work for the benefit of mankind without any distinction of caste, creed, religion, nationality and to help the Government in all its constructive and welfare activities without participating in any political activities.

(4) To raise and expend funds for the aforesaid purposes.

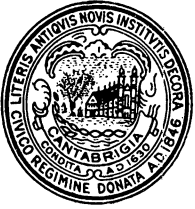
