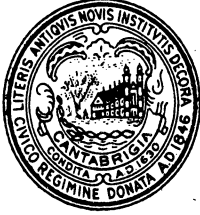

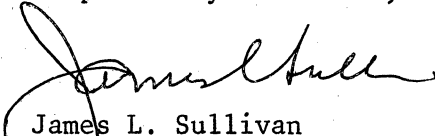
To the Honorable, the City Council:

The Executive Committee of Cambridge's 350th Anniversary has approved the creation and installation of a sculpture to be installed in Winthrop Park to commemorate the 350th Anniversary of the founding of Cambridge. It would appear from the discussions that have taken place that the sculpture will be unique, creative and historical, and will be a fitting monument to this anniversary of Cambridge's founding.

Since the installation of the structure will require the foundation to be built by the Public Works Department, and since it involves a public park within the City, permission of the Council is requested to install this sculpture at this location.
