Resolved

That in the opinion of this Board obstructing the full & free flow of tide water through the bridges crossing Miller's river will be detrimental to the public health & more liable to create than to prevent a nuisance & bearing with regret that the City of Cambridge are about to obstruct the full flow of tide water this Board respectfully protest against the closing or obstructing any of the passages to or through any of the bridges across said river.
