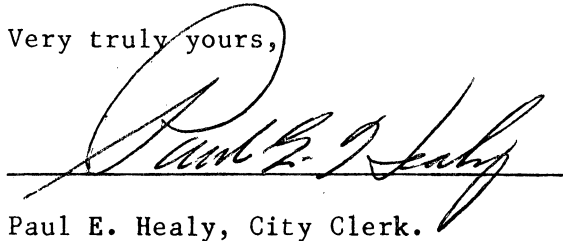
Dear Senator Atkins:

COUNCILLOR GRAHAM

- WHEREAS: It has come to the attention of this City Council that through a recently enacted State Law, Chapter 661 of the Acts of 1983, the Cambridge Retirement Board, in compliance with this statute will not be providing interest from deductions of municipal employees salaries if said employee is a member of the system for less than five years; and
- WHEREAS: This City Council wishes to address what appears to be an inequity in the law, specifically the mandating of employees to join the retirement system, while prohibiting the local boards from granting interest to members with under five years of service; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record requesting the City Manager to contact Senator Chester Atkins, sponsor of this legislation and to request the Senator to attend the City Council meeting of March 19, 1984, in order to discuss this issue.

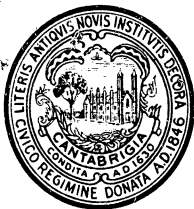

IMPORTANT NOTICE - PLEASE POST

TO: MEMBERS OF THE CAMBRIDGE RETIREMENT SYSTEM

RE: CHANGES IN THE RETIREMENT LAW

SECTION 4 amends M.G.L., Chapter 32, Section 11 (1)(a) by limiting the interest to members who VOLUNTARILY withdraw from service and seek a return of accumulated deductions after January 1, 1984.

No interest will be refunded to members who have voluntarily terminated their employment prior to accruing five (5) years of creditable service.

Members who have voluntarily terminated their employment and have accrued at least five (5) years of creditable service but less than ten (10) years of creditable service will receive 50% of the accrued interest upon withdrawal.

Members with ten (10) years of creditable service shall receive one hundred (100%) interest upon withdrawal.

Please note that this section does not apply to members whose services were INVOLUNTARILY terminated.
