To the Honorable, the City Council:

In response to Awaiting Report Item Number 03-116, regarding a report on the ownership of streets, sidewalks, and parking areas in the area encompassed by Charles, Binney, Fulkerson, and Third Streets, Traffic, Parking & Transportation Director Susan Clippinger reports the following:

The City of Cambridge owns and controls all streets and sidewalks within the area bounded by Charles, Binney, Fulkerson and Third Streets, with the exception of certain portions of Rogers Street as noted below:

1. Rogers Street between Fulkerson and Sixth Street is privately owned, mostly by Rogers Street LLC – A subsidiary of Lyme Properties. A portion of the street along the 300 Bent Street property is owned by Paul Lohnes.
2. Rogers Street between Sixth and Fifth Streets is owned by the City.
3. Rogers Street between Fifth and third Streets is both publicly and privately owned. Worthington Place Associates owns the entire southern half of the street, as well as a short portion of the northern half approximately half way between fifth and third. The City of Cambridge owns the northern half of Rogers Street, except for the portion half way between Fifth and Third.

An overview map is attached.

All on street parking is controlled by the owner of the particular street in question. All off street parking is controlled by the corresponding property owner on the attached map. All off street parking spaces in the City must be inventoried and registered with the Traffic, Parking & Transportation Department.
