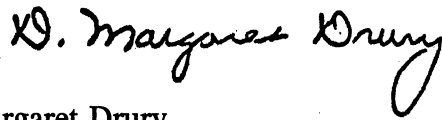

WHEREAS: The rank of **Sergeant** includes the designation of "superior officer" in the Cambridge Police Department; and

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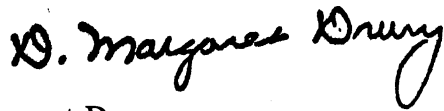

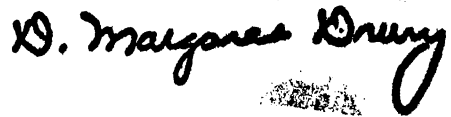
