WHEREAS: The Department of Public Works has recently conducted a survey relating to rubbish pickup for commercial accounts throughout the City; and

WHEREAS: As a result of this survey, a number of non-profit organizations serving low/moderate income residents have been notified to pay a rubbish collection fee; and

WHEREAS: It is not appropriate and would be a hardship for these non-profit organizations, many of which have faced severe cutbacks in Federal, State and local funds, to pay this rubbish collection fee; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to develop a procedure to exempt non-profit organizations serving low to moderate income residents from the rubbish collection fee and for the Department of Human Services Programs to notify the organizations about this exemption.
