- WHEREAS: Joe was born in Newton, Massachusetts, where he attended local schools and later graduated from Boston State College with a Bachelor of Science degree in Education; and
- WHEREAS: Joe served his country during the Korean War and upon being honorably discharged, served as a Police Officer in Auburn, Maine; and
- WHEREAS: While serving as a Police Officer, Joe's Juvenile Program was featured in the National Police Publication Law and Order, a program he established to assist juveniles, an attribute he has always maintained and which was recognized by both former Governor Endicott Peabody and the late Attorney General Robert Kennedy, whom Joe served as a consultant on juvenile crime and delinquency; and
- WHEREAS: While Joe has been serving as the Council Executive of the Cambridge Boy Scouts of America, he has been the recipient of several awards by the National Office for his untiring leadership and dedication, resulting in the Cambridge Council being brought to national prominence for both financial and membership growth; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its sincere congratulations and a hearty "well-done" to Joseph P. Savignano for his dedication and sincerity to the Cambridge Boy Scouts; and be it further
