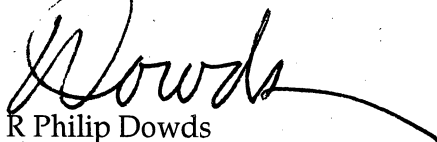
Re: **No On Nine**

Honorable Councillors:

At its regular meeting of 22 September 1994, the Board of Directors of the CCA was unanimous in the view that State Ballot Question Nine (which seeks an instantaneous repeal of rent control) is an irresponsible and destructive interference with both the home rule authority and the local housing market of Cambridge. We strongly urge you to mobilize all feasible political, legal, and financial resources to the end of defeating Question Nine at the ballot box and, if necessary, in the courts and State legislature.
