ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to instruct the Director of Traffic and Parking to conduct a vehicular traffic study of the Mount Auburn Street, Homer Avenue, Belmont Street and Holworthy Street area, in order to consider the feasibility of re-designing the traffic pattern in this area so that a more orderly and safe pattern may be established; and be it further

ORDERED: That until such time as a comprehensive traffic design program is established, the City Manager be and hereby is requested to instruct the Chief of Police to establish radar patrols in this area to reduce the number of speeding vehicles.
