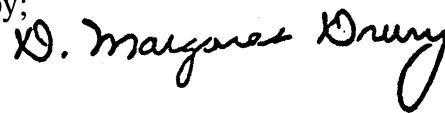

Resolved, that one goal from the goals previously adopted by the Council be placed on the agenda of the first meeting of each month between February 1998 and May of 1998 so that they all may be reviewed and discussed in depth with the City Manager and staff prior to the adoption of the budget in May/June 1998.

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2. Resolution Regarding Annual Retreat and Goal Setting Session of the City

Council

Whereas, it is desirable for the City Council to delineate the goals and policies of the City for each year prior to the adoption of the budget;

Whereas, the Manager presents his goals in January and the budget is adopted in May/June and it is desirable for the Council to adopt policies and goals within the time frame necessary (October/November) to affect the budget decision making process and considered in a timely fashion; now therefore be it

Resolved, that the City Council schedule an annual retreat facilitated by an appropriate professional at the end of June in order to discuss and prepare goals for the coming fiscal year which will be adopted by the Council by the end of October of that year, the intention being that the City Council goals can be taken into early consideration by the City Manager in his preparation of the annual budget and his yearly goals.
