Dear Frank:

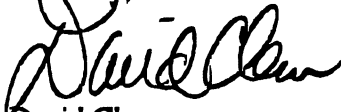
The Planning Board has indicated that they do not expect to make a recommendation regarding the so-called Vendetti Petition until their December 15, 1998 meeting. This falls after the 21 day time period when they normally issue a recommendation. Consequently, the City Council is free to act after December 9, 1998, without the Planning Board Recommendation.

I understand the City Council, which held its required hearing on October 20, 1998 (Ordinance Committee), may consider the petition for a second reading as early as tonight. Ordinarily, I would expect the City Council to advertise the petition for 14 days prior to considering an ordination vote. I would also expect the City Council would not ordinarily vote prior to receiving the reports it requested from the City Manager at the Ordinance Committee Hearing. (Don Drisdell informs me that outside counsel has been retained by the City to assist in the preparation of the report requested by the City Council; I do not know if this report is complete or has been forwarded to the City Council.)

Since the Vendetti Petition affects our site, I respectfully ask that we have the opportunity to appear before the City Council prior to any ordination vote and have the opportunity to make a brief presentation. I presume the earliest this might happen is Monday, December 21, 1998 but I would appreciate learning about any scheduling constraints due to the holiday season.

Please contact me at your earliest convenience to advise me of the Council's scheduling intentions. I would appreciate your help in being allowed to speak to the entire City Council prior to any final vote.
