WHEREAS: Closer ties between the people of Cambridge and the people of Thailand were established following the birth of His Majesty King Bhumibol Adulyadej of Thailand at Mount Auburn Hospital, Cambridge on December 5, 1927 while his father Prince Mahidol was enrolled at Harvard Medical School; and

WHEREAS: In commemoration of this royal birth a square was dedicated in his name of April 8, 1990 at Harvard Square, Cambridge by Her Royal Highness Princess Chulabhorn; and

WHEREAS: Representing King Bhumibol Adulyadej and the people of Thailand, Her Royal Highness Princess Maha Chakri Sirindhorn, the widely travelled, well educated and highly decorated daughter of Their Majesties King Bhumibol and Queen Sirikit of Thailand will unveil a plaque at Eliot and Bennett Streets, Harvard Square on November 14, 1992 at 10:30 a.m.; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That I, Mayor Kenneth E. Reeves and the Cambridge City Council do hereby acclaim the naming of KING BHUMIBOL ADULYADEJ SQUARE as we unite in a lasting bond of friendship.
