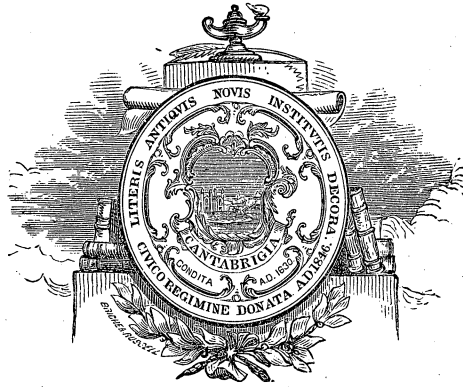


CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.
