REFERENCE:

In response to City Council Order #3 of 6/24/91 regarding an "unfortunate incident" which took place to a teenager while at Alberico Playground on Allston Street, a review of Department files and a check with C.I.D., Youth Unit and Crime Analysis does not reveal any reported crime either at the playground or in the area for the month of June.

Without knowing the specifics, it is difficult for the Police Department to investigate and to prevent either a recurrence or future problem. The teenager should contact Lieutenant Walter Boyle, Commanding Officer of C.I.D., at 349-3370.

Once the specifics of the incident have been identified, the respective route and sector units will be requested to give extra attention to the Alberico Playground.

Adopted by the affirmative vote of nine members.

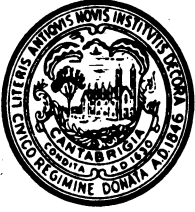
