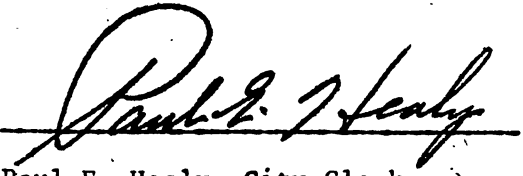
MAYOR SULLIVAN
