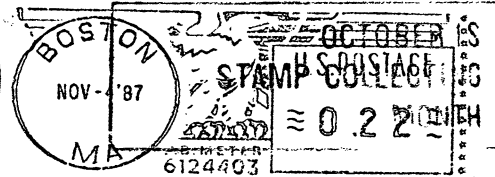
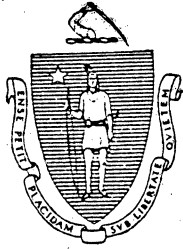

MDC BEGINS FALL TREE PLANTING

As part of an ongoing, extensive beautification effort, the Metropolitan District Commission has begun fall tree plantings in areas of Cambridge and Somerville.

Trees are being planted on parts of Soldiers Field Road, Greenough Boulevard, Memorial Drive and Fresh Pond Parkway in Cambridge and the Alewife Brook Parkway and Mystic Valley Parkway in Somerville. Varieties include Red Maple, American Linden, Pin Oak and Japanese Zelkova.

The MDC is planting a total of over 1,000 trees in several communities along numerous parkways, boulevards, drives and other areas in Boston and north, south and west of the city.

The contractor, A.J. Tomasi Nurseries, Inc. of Hingham, will complete the \$175,000 tree planting program by the end of November.
