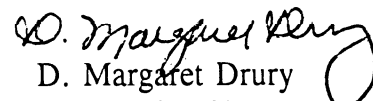

To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting the appropriation and authorization to borrow \$9,830,000.00 to provide funds for both extensive improvements and an addition to the Morse School. Of the total planned space of 73,373 square feet, 19,253 square feet will be allocated to new construction with the remaining 54,120 square feet set aside for improvements to the existing facility. It is important to emphasize that my recommendation is conditional upon the City receiving 90% reimbursement for both principal and interest costs from the School Building Assistance Bureau.

This appropriation includes funds for furniture, basic equipment and technology/computer equipment as well as architectural and construction costs.
