WHEREAS: Firefighter Harrington was first appointed to the department on February 4, 1951 at which time he was assigned to Engine Company 9 where he remained until January 29, 1956 when he was transferred to Engine Company 4, and

WHEREAS: Having served briefly in this assignment he was transferred on September 16, 1956 to Engine Company 8 where he served until November 12, 1967 when he was transferred to Rescue Company 1 where he remained until January 4, 1970 when he was transferred back to Engine Company 4, an assignment he held until June 20, 1976 when he was transferred to Engine Company 7 where he remained until he retired on April 11, 1977, now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending our sincere gratitude to Firefighter John P. Harrington for his dedication to duty for a total of 26 years and to further extend to him our best wishes for a healthy and happy retirement, and be it further

RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to prepare for presentation a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution on behalf of the entire City Council.
