- ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to direct the Community Development Department to conduct a postcard survey of all residents of Ward 1, Precinct 1 in East Cambridge to determine the will of the community regarding the proposal to discontinue a portion of Otis Street between Second and Third Streets as a public way for the purpose of constructing and maintaining a pedestrian way and park to be known as Bulfinch Square in accord with a park maintenance agreement providing for lawn and planting maintenance, fountain maintenance, site furniture maintenance, surface cleaning and trash maintenance; which park will provide relaxation and enjoyment for pedestrians with no commercial activities of any kind to be conducted on the site; and be it further
- ORDERED: That after the survey is complete and the results posted, that a hearing be held before the City Council to which all concerned residents be invited to appear and be heard.
