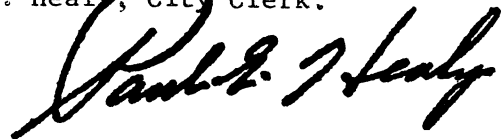

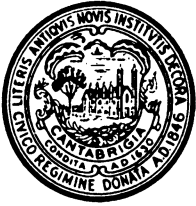

To the Honorable, the City Council:

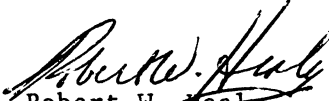
Attached please find for your review and action an order requesting the acceptance and appropriation of a matching grant in the amount of \$30,000 from the Massachusetts Historical Commission to the Public Investment Fund, Public Library section.

This appropriation will supplement existing funds (\$68,000 appropriated in the FY86 capital budget) to replace 138 windows in the old building of the Main Library.

These new windows would allow for ventilation in summer and fuel conservation in the winter, as well as making the building less accessible to vandals.

Passage of this order is recommended.
