WHEREAS:-

The City of Cambridge cannot enforce any type of control of rents without such enabling legislation, and

WHEREAS:-

The proposed legislation now resides in the Ways and Means Committee, now therefore be it

ORDERED:-

That the City Council urgently requests Governor Sargent and President Donahue to make joint efforts to have such legislation passed, or to promote the special bill which was submitted on this subject by this City Council, and that copies of this order be sent to the Cambridge delegation of the General Court and to the newspapers.
