- WHEREAS: It has come to the attention of this City Council that Dr. C. George Hori, Chief of Pathology at the Cambridge Hospital will soon retire; and
- WHEREAS: Dr. Hori, who was born in Japan, received his primary and secondary education in Vancouver, British Columbia and received a Bachelor of Arts with honors from the University of British Columbia in 1935, a Medical Degree with honors from the University of Chicago Medical School in 1939, as well as a Doctorate of Public Health from the University of Toronto in 1954; and
- WHEREAS: Dr. Hori did his intern and residency work in Chicago, prior to becoming a Resident of Pathology at the Cambridge Hospital between 1964 and 1966, going to the New England Deaconess Hospital and Peter Bent Brigham Hospital in July of 1966 as a Pathology Resident, remaining there until December of 1968, at which time he transferred to the Lenox Hill Hospital in New York; and
- WHEREAS: Dr. Hori was appointed Director of Laboratories and Chief of Pathology at the Cambridge Hospital on January 1, 1970, the position from which he will soon retire, completing sixteen years of dedicated service to the Cambridge Hospital; and
- WHEREAS: Dr. Hori, in addition to maintaining dual roles at the Hospital, he has served as a Consulting Pathologist in charge of the Laboratory at Harvard University Health Services, Associate Professor of Pathology at Harvard and as an Adjunct Professor at Suffolk University, the University of Massachusetts and Emmanuel College, and has recently been reappointed as the Medical Examiner for the First District of Middlesex County; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its sincere appreciation and gratitude to Dr. C. George Hori for his dedicated service to the Cambridge Hospital and the people it serves, and to further extend every good wish for good health and happiness in all his future endeavors; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That in recognition of Dr. Hori's service, this City Council hereby goes on record naming the pathology laboratory of the Cambridge Hospital as the C. George Hori, M. D., M. Sc. (HYG.), D. P. H. Laboratory, and further requests the City Manager to instruct the Commissioner of Health and Hospitals to take the necessary steps to arrange for a suitable plaque and ceremony to be held in honor of Dr. Hori; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Dr. Hori on behalf of the entire City Council.
