- WHEREAS: It has come to the attention of this City Council that Joseph A. Pavo, a long time Cambridge resident, will soon celebrate 40 years of public service at the Middlesex County Courthouse; and
- WHEREAS: Joseph began his public career in 1946 as an employee of the Registry of Deeds, remaining there until 1950, at which time he was transferred to the Clerk of Courts Office for the Superior Court; and
- WHEREAS: Joseph, a 1956 Boston College graduate and ardent supporter of Boston College, also received a Master of Education degree in 1958 from Suffolk University; and
- WHEREAS: Joe served his country with distinction during the Korean Conflict as a member of the United States Army, interrupting his public service career and upon being honorably discharged, returned to the Middlesex County Courthouse; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record congratulating Joseph A. Pavo for his 40 years of dedicated and tireless public service for the people of Middlesex County; and further to extend to him every good wish for health and happiness; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Joseph A. Pavo, on behalf of the entire City Council.
