WHEREAS:-

Under an order adopted by the City Council on May 24, 1938 the condition of the shower baths at the Cambridge Field Shelter was brought to the attention of His Honor, the Mayor and the Board of Park Commissioners and

WHEREAS:-

The condition of said baths have in the last ten months grown infinitely worse thereby increasing the unsanitary and unhealthy conditions in the vicinity and

WHEREAS:-

The health and safety of the public should be considered paramount to the small expenditure necessarily involved in improving the disgraceful conditions now existing it is

ORDERED:-

That the Board of Park Commissioners be and hereby is requested to report at the next meeting of the City Council what action they propose to take in this matter and if no correction of conditions is proposed it is further

ORDERED:-

That His Honor, the Mayor be and hereby is requested in the interest of the health and safety of the public to close these baths forthwith.
