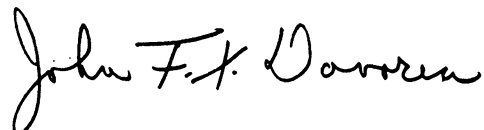

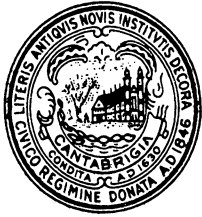

1. The name by which the corporation shall be known is:

ORCHARD PARK INTERAGENCY COUNCIL, INCORPORATED

2. The purposes for which the corporation is formed are as follows:

To work in coordination with the residents of the Orchard Park area of the City of Boston for the purpose of developing and strengthening the programs and services of member agencies that serve the social, recreational, medical, and economic needs of the residents of Orchard Park. To unilaterally initiate and also to cooperate with private, federal, state and city agencies in developing, programs for security, civic, educational, charitable or benevolent purposes. To establish and maintain places for ~~reading~~ reading rooms, libraries, or social meetings. To improve and ornament the streets and public squares of Boston by improving the physical aspects of Boston and furthering the recreation of the inhabitants thereof. And, specifically, but not being limited thereby, to further the interests of the residents of the Orchard Park area of the City of Boston. The purposes of the corporation shall be exclusively charitable and educational. No property of the Corporation shall inure to and benefit any member, officer, employee, or other individual associated with the Corporation. The Corporation shall not participate or engage in any activity or practice which is prohibited by section 501 of the Internal Revenue Code or successive provisions thereof.

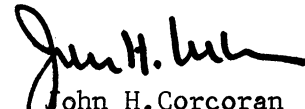
