WHEREAS: Bob Cain, as he is familiarly known, strengthened the social services for the YMCA residents by initiating innovative programs, among which was his development of a model partnership with the Harvard Divinity School, whereby the Divinity School's resources were made more available to the residents of the YMCA; and

WHEREAS: He has been called to serve as Pastor of St. Paul's Episcopal Church in Natick, Massachusetts, preaching and responding to the needs of a new community of people; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That this City Council expresses its appreciation to Reverend G. Robert Cain for the contribution which his presence brought to the Cambridge Family YMCA, and wishes him success in this new dimension of the religious vocation; and be it further
