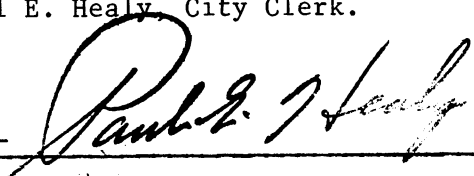

- WHEREAS: Dr. Canning has attended the Criminal Justice Instructional School and has been certified as a Suicide Prevention Instructor; and
- WHEREAS: Dr. Canning, under the direction of Captain Henry W. Breen, Jr., teaches the nature, profile and symptomatology of suicide, as well as the policy for dealing with all prisoners in the custody of the Cambridge Police; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its sincere appreciation to Dr. Suzanne Canning and Captain Henry Breen for their combined efforts in this vital and sensitive area; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Dr. Canning and Captain Breen on behalf of the entire City Council.
