WHEREAS: On April 10, 1978, the City Council conducted a public hearing relative to the proposed expansion of Victory Gardens in the City of Cambridge, and

WHEREAS: At this hearing, the residents of Harvard, Moore and Clark Streets in East Cambridge indicated their desire to expand the Victory Garden Program by the acquisition of more land adjacent to the Margaret Fuller House in their neighborhood, therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to direct the Commissioner of Public Works to survey the area in question with a view towards setting aside or acquiring land in this neighborhood to expand the Victory Garden Program, and be it further

ORDERED: That the Commissioner of Public Works confer with the appropriate authorities at the Margaret Fuller House to obtain the required permission to inaugurate this program, and be it further

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to report to this City Council within one week the action taken by him pursuant to this order.
