With respect to Awaiting Report Item No. 24, please be advised that the Traffic Department is conducting a study of the intersection of Berkshire and Plymouth Streets with a view towards installing either a Traffic Signal or a Warning Beacon at this intersection. As soon as the data is collected a request will be submitted to the State for a decision. A previous request for a full Stop and Go signal for this intersection was turned down as it did not meet the requirements set forth by the State.

At the present time, there are two highly visible stop signs on the east and west side of Plymouth Street at this intersection.
