WHEREAS: At the moment Boston Ballet Company, an important member of the Cambridge arts community is in need of financial assistance to bring it through the holiday season; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council affirm its support for the work of the Boston Ballet Company and the superior instruction and performances it offers of the work of one of classical ballet's greatest geniuses, George Balanchine, and request the City Manager to investigate possible loans or grants the City could offer or facilitate to keep this organization in the City of Cambridge.

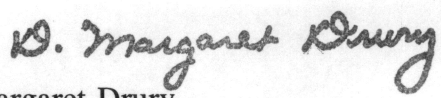
